

CONWAY YOUTH BASEBALL RULES

PONY LEAGUE

REVISED 2-1-12

1. USSSA rules will be followed unless otherwise stated. www.arkansasusssa.com
2. All bats conforming to the usssa rule addressing bats for the 2011 season will be acceptable for league play. Players playing in tournaments outside of league play will be required to conform to the new rules specifying bats allowed for 2012.
3. Pony League is for 13, 14 & 15 year olds only.
4. This is a kid pitch league.
5. Pitchers can pitch 6 innings a week.
6. One pitch constitutes an inning.
7. All players will bat in rotation.
8. Normal defensive positioning will be used.
9. Coin flip will determine home and visitor.
10. One hour and forty-five minute time limit or six innings.
11. Six runs max an inning or three outs.
12. No jewelry unless health related and then it must be taped down.
13. Metal cleats will be allowed.
14. Leading off and stealing will be allowed.
15. Run Rule – After 4 completed innings, if a team is up by 13 or more runs the game will be called.
16. Only the batter and the on deck batter allowed outside the dugout.
17. Catchers must wear a protective cup.
18. Catcher may be pinch ran for by the player making the last out. Catcher must have caught previous inning.
19. Shirttails will be tucked in and hats must be facing forward.
20. Infield fly rule is in effect.
21. Dropped third strike rule is in effect.
22. Slide rule is in effect. Umpire has the discretion to call someone out for not sliding. This is a judgment call and will be final.
23. We will not tolerate foul language or abusive behavior towards the kids, umpires or any employee of the parks and recreation. First offense will result in an open suspension.
24. Ejection from a game for a player or coach will result in an open suspension and that person or persons must exit the park grounds immediately.
25. No soft toss allowed into the fence.
26. No drinking allowed in the park.
27. All City of Conway parks are tobacco-free facilities.
28. No dogs allowed.
29. Parks and Recreation will provide an official scorekeeper.
30. Please have your line-up turned in to the scorekeeper 10 minutes before game time.
31. Parks and Recreation reserves the right to change rules as needed.
